ST. CLAIR COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT

Lt. Colonel Thomas Knapp reported the following for the month of April 01, 2025, ending April 30, 2025, which included the following data: Average Daily Population was 428, inmates admitted 555 of those 151 were females, 404 were males, 212 misdemeanors, 223 felons, 9 Federal, 78 fugitives, and 0 Transcor. Sentence Weekend Bookings 20, Sentence County Bookings 2, D.O.C. 11 and Other 0. There were 91 traffic citations, 128 traffic warnings, 36 felony/misdemeanors/warrant arrests, 466 park patrols, 1063 business checks, and 27 courthouse checks, for a total of 957 points of contact with the general public.
