Action Item: Approve the easement vacation Lot 8 of the Estates at Heritage Landing.

- A) Resolution authorizing the award of the 2026 Oil and Chip Program, Section # 26-00000-00-GM to the low bidder, DMS Contracting, Inc in the amount of \$1,298,496.30. Funding to be from the County Motor Fuel Tax.
- B) Resolution authorizing the award of the rock salt purchase 2026-2027, Section 26-(1-19)000-01-GM to the low bidder, Morton Salt in the amount of \$2,354,009.00. The County portion to be funded from the County Motor Fuel Tax.
- C) Resolution authorizing the firm of Bacon, Farmer, Workman Engineering and Testing to prepare a bridge condition report for the bridge which carries Five Forks over Silver Creek in the amount of \$24,603.00. Section 26-00087-07-ES is to be funded from the County Bridge Fund.
- D) Resolution authorizing a modification the existing contract with Volkert, Inc for the Press Road Bridge over Richland Creek, Section 22-18101-05-BR due to the increased work scope. The amount of the increase to be \$19,818.00 and to be paid from the County Highway Fund.
- E) Resolution authorizing an agreement with St. Clair County Transit District for the project known as Bunkum Road Trail Phase 1.
- F) Resolution authorizing a joint agreement with the Illinois Department of Transportation for the improvements to Ashland Avenue and Old Collinsville Road. The County portion to be \$303,710.00 or as much as is needed. Section 19-00276-07-PW is to be funded using County Matching Funds.

- G) Resolution authorizing an Agreement with the Village of Shiloh related to TIF Funds to be used on the Frank Scott Parkway Widening Project.
- H) Resolution authorizing a permit to Socket Fiber to install a buried fiber line under Frank Scott Parkway east of IL 159. All previously approved requirements to apply.
- I) Resolution authorizing a permit to i3 Broadband to install a buried communication line along the south side of Frank Scott Parkway at the intersection of Sullivan Drive heading east. All previously approved requirements to apply.
- J) Resolution authorizing a permit to i3 Broadband to install a buried communication line on Sullivan Drive from Huntwood northerly to the developments on both sides. All previously approved requirements to apply
- K) Resolution authorizing the purchase of one Lazer Z X Series 37 HP Vanguard Ultra Cut Zero Turn with Tractus Tires from Bi-County Small Engine Center in the amount of \$17,399.00. Funding to be from the Highway Equipment Trust Fund with Section #26-00000-07-EQ.
- L) Resolution authorizing the 6th Cider Man Event on September 12, 2026. All previous County Road Use provisions apply.
